




Reconstructive Urology

Dr. Inouye and his team have expertise in cancer survivorship, including severe complications from radiation and chemotherapy that impact the genitourinary system. Recognizing that reconstructive urology patients have often endured challenging treatment courses, the practice provides individualized care focused on restoring function and improving quality of life.

Treatment planning emphasizes evidence-based surgical techniques tailored to each patient's unique clinical situation, whether addressing stricture disease, incontinence, traumatic injury, or post-oncologic complications. The practice maintains detailed consultation reports and close communication with referring providers throughout the treatment and recovery process.
